## A time for classic design

Since 10 October 1989, the day the *Vienna Philharmonic* bullion coin first appeared in the marketplace, we have remained true to ourselves in terms of the coin's design. Crafted with special precision, the award-winning motif has remained the same since the very first edition, with only the year of issue changing. One side of the coin depicts a harmonious collection of musical instruments from the world-famous Vienna Philharmonic orchestra – a Vienna horn, a bassoon and a harp, with a cello in the centre and a viola and violin on either side. The other side features the organ of the Musikverein concert hall, the orchestra's home. A world-famous brand, the *Vienna Philharmonic* is highly valued everywhere.

The gold *Vienna Philharmonic* is available in five sizes: 1 ounce, 1/2 ounce, 1/4 ounce, 1/10 ounce and 1/25 ounce. The silver *Vienna Philharmonic* is available in the 1 ounce size. The platinum version is available in 1 ounce and 1/25 ounce. *The above images show the actual size of the coins.*
